We store all our wine in a temperature controlled environment and serve them in Riedel stemware.

All of our wines have been chosen by the Wine Director for their quality and adaptability to pair with Chef Mark Kiffin's menu. The list is arranged from white to red, categorized by varietals and country. New Mexico law allows for you to take a partial bottle with you when you leave, we will be glad to prepare your partial bottle for travel.
