**A Family Tradition**

Throughout Europe and the Old World, winemaking has been a family tradition for hundreds of years. Wineries and vineyards, as well as knowledge and skills, have been passed on for generations upon generations. The following are a few of the many family owned and operated wineries on the wine list that you may not have known about.

**Gruet** - in 1984, the Gruet family decided to purchase land in New Mexico to plant vineyards and make sparkling wine, just like the family had in France for so many years and have expanded into the still wine territory

**Kunde Family Estate** - in 1904 Louis Kunde acquired the Wildwood vineyard and the Kunde family has celebrated over 100 years and five generations' of family owned and operated wine making.

**Shafer Vineyards** - in 1978 John Shafer crushed his first Cabernet grapes and began construction of his winery a year later. His Cabernet has been a benchmark for Napa Valley ever since. In 1983 his son Doug took over as winemaker and is now the president of the winery. This wine is a celebration of one point five generations!

**Caymus** - The Wagner family legacy of winemaking has been carried on for three generations. Charlie F. Wagner and Lorna Belle Glos Wagner, along with their son, Chuck, established Caymus Vineyards in 1972. As a teenager, Charlie began making wine alongside his father. Charlie and his brother Joe, winemaker of Belle Glos, grew up learning and carrying on the viticulture practices of the Wagner family.
